

Supplies and Where to Get Them

One of the most fabulous things about Hobbit Hill is the location. And, if you suddenly run out of milk, we are a few miles from the nearest supplies, so it is good to be prepared!

The nearest shop for milk and bread etc is Millie's, which is the little café in Hurst Green. (Great bacon butties and really good coffee) It's open Wednesday to Sunday from 9am-4:30pm.

The Spar in Clitheroe is the next nearest shop (3.7 miles away)

Handily, they sell most phone chargers – Android and iPhone
